

INTRODUCTION

Hi there! We pray that this prayer handbook empowers you to pray in response to God's heart for Hong Kong and His calling for you in His city!

GOD'S HEART FOR

THE CITY

"And should I not have concern for the great city of Nineveh, in which there are more than a hundred and twenty thousand people who cannot tell their right hand from their left - and also many animals?"

JONAH 4:11 (NIV)



In the Book of Jonah, we are reminded of God's compassion for the people in the cities. There, God calls on His messenger Jonah to travel to Nineveh; a "great city" of more than a hundred and twenty thousand people whose sins had come up before the Lord (Jonah 1:2), to tell them to turn from their old ways. It is hard to to imagine why God cared for a city that profaned His name and opposed His ways! But there is perhaps no better explanation than Jonah's: the God we serve is a "gracious God and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, and relenting from disaster" (Jonah 4:2). Although Ninevites were wholly undeserving of His mercy, God, not wanting the city of Nineveh to be overthrown and perish, sought to restore Nineveh as a glorious city of the Lord through its people's repentant hearts.

As we turn our gaze to the great city that we ourselves have been placed in, do we see God's heart for Nineveh's restoration here in Hong Kong? In Jeremiah 29:7, we are reminded that God purposefully calls us into cities, so that in our intercession we may be able to participate in God's glorious plan of transforming and prospering the city!

Our city has been hurting from the grievous effects of the pandemic, with many experiencing feelings of helplessness and heaviness.

Although we may feel powerless to respond, It is in times like these that God uproots us from our complacency and reminds us of how much our city depends on him, ultimately driving us to pray!

"Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have called you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."

JEREMIAH 29:7 (NIV)

THE SOCIETY IN OUR CITY



Hong Kong is a diverse city filled with people from all walks of life, but it is also very divided, whether it's because of differing beliefs or the marginalized, such as refugees or migrant workers. After 2.5 years, pandemic and social unrest amplified the already existing problems.

Many people have left because they feel hopeless, but our hope is not in the circumstances and in the promise that God is still doing His wonderworks in healing our city. Let's pray for the governing authorities making key decisions for our city, and God's heart for the its embedded societal issues; the political and socio-economic divisions and marginalisation.

HOW WE CAN PRAY FOR THE SOCIETY:

- Pray for protection and providence for the marginalized in the day-to-day basis
- Pray for sustainable frameworks to be built to support those who are marginalized
- Pray for God's empowerment of HK's governing authorities as they make difficult decisions for our city
- Pray for the Gospel to reach and bring healing to societal divisions

Scriptures to meditate on as you pray for our city's society:

Timothy 2:1-4 (ESV)

"First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth."

Psalm 68:5-6 (NLT)

"Father to the fatherless, defender of widows - this is God, whose dwelling is holy. God places the lonely in families; he sets the prisoners free and gives them joy. But he makes the rebellious live in the sun-scorched land."

PRAYER

Dear Heavenly Father,

You have said: "How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity... For there the Lord bestows his blessing, even life forevermore" (Psalm 133:1-3). We are broken by the division that we see in the city. We pray for the unity of the society as we learn to be selfless and sacrificial. We also pray for wisdom for the government to make God-fearing decisions. May Your blessings overflow in the city and may we see transformation in every sector of Hong Kong.

SPIRITUAL WELFARE OF THE CITY

Spiritual welfare can be defined as how connected people are with God and whether we are living out their faith in God. This is important to our city, because there are still many people who don't know the Gospel, the unconditional love and hope that God offers in the midst of our struggles. The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few (Matthew 9:37).

1 Corinthians 12:12-26 says, "For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ....If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together." As we're all one body in Christ, the spiritual welfare of our church and other churches is key for our city to be transformed into a city that reflects God's love.

- Recovery of local businesses



MENTAL HEALTH OF OUR CITY



Mental health is a global issue affecting people of all ages and with the COVID-19 pandemic, there are more people than ever suffering from poor mental health. 61% of Hong Kong adults currently suffer from poor mental well-being and more than half of secondary school students have experienced symptoms of depression (HK Food and Health Bureau). Among university students, 69% reported symptoms of depression while 54% suffer from anxiety (SCMP).

Mental health affects how we think, feel, and act and determines how we handle stress, relate to others, and make choices. Unfortunately, mental illness is often seen as a weakness and this social stigma discourages people from reaching out for help. Let's learn more about HK's mental health situation to pray for the city.

HOW WE CAN PRAY FOR THE SOCIETY:

- Increasing depression and anxiety levels.
- Crisis level of suicides during COVID-19


PRAYER

Prayer walking

ON THE STREETS OF YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

For example, you might notice a local secondary school and feel led to lift up a prayer for the students in your area.

Set a date

COMMIT TO WEEKLY OR DAILY PRAYING FOR HONG KONG

Involve others
