OUR DAILY BREAD



Matthew 6:11

The Hebrew root word of "provide" (Jireh) means not only "to give or to supply" but also

"Give us this day our daily bread"

"to perceive, inspect, experience, and consider." Our Lord is a God who also **perceives** our needs, **experiences** life with us, and **fully understands** us. He will provide exactly what we need when we need it.

- He is our Good Father
- He is our Good Shepherd

BECAUSE GOD Provides

- We can trust Him
- We can seek Him

He is our Good Shepherd

Psalm 23:1-2 (ESV)

"The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters."

- God guides us along the right paths He cares for us, protects us, and has sacrificed Himself that we might know Him and be satisfied.
- Even when we are going through difficult seasons, we lack nothing because God will always provide refuge and sustain us.

He is our Good Father



Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV)

"For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope."

- God has provided a great purpose and plan for our lives, and He promises to give us everything we need day by day.
- However, God might not provide in the way we expect because like any good parent, He gives us not what we might want, but rather what we need.

We can trust Him

Luke 12:24 (ESV)

"Consider the ravens: they neither sow nor reap, they have neither storehouse nor barn, and yet God feeds them. Of how much more value are you than the birds!"

 As God's precious children, we can trust His goodness for us and His shepherding character to do far more than we could ever imagine.



Matthew 6:33 (ESV)

"But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."

 As we seek and abide in His word daily, God promises to give us abundant and eternal life.
